AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PART OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 21, PINE COUNTY,
MINNESOTA, TO VILLAGE OF MINCKLEY

The Village Council of Minckley ordains:

Section I: WHEREAS, Twiss, Inc., a corporation, as the owner of the
hereinafter described premises:

Lot Twelve (12), Auditor's Subdivision of Northeast Quarter of
Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Twenty-five (25),
Township Forty-one (41), Range Twenty-one (21), except
the northerly 38 feet, and except that part within the
limits of Highway No. 35,

and

WHEREAS, John Schrade and Esther Schrade, his wife, as the owners of the
hereinafter described premises:

That part of the South Eight (8) acres of the North one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the

municipality, and


