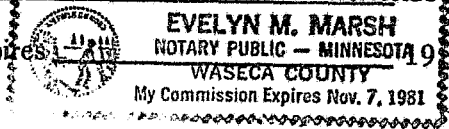



An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Grand Rapids to Include Certain Unincorporated Territory Surrounded on Three (3) Sides and by More Than Sixty Percent (60%) by Land Within the Village Limits and Abutting Thereon.

Whereas, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

Whereas, this territory is surrounded on three (3) sides and by more than sixty percent (60%) by lands already included within the corporate limits of the village and is deemed to be urban in character. The Village Council of the Village of Grand Rapids ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory as follows, which territory now is and has heretofore been surrounded on three (3) sides and by over sixty percent (60%) by territory already included within the village limits:

North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$), of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Section 2. Filing. The village clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
