

ORDINANCE NO. 363

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY  
OF HUTCHINSON AND ANNEXING THERETO CERTAIN ALND FORMERLY  
LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LYNN

THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON DOES ORDAIN:

Section I: A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, by Kenneth F. Born for Midwest Modules, Inc.; Russell E. Haigh; Orville J. Lund; Edna A. Lund; Alvina Steffenson and S. P. Steffenson, being one hundred percent sole owners of the following described real property, to have said property annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Hutchinson, Gounty of McLeod, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

South three-quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 12 Twp. 116, Range 30; and Northeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter; exception beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 12 Twp. 116 N-Range 30 W; thence westerly along the North line of Section 12, a distance of 445.0 feet; thence southerly parallel to the east line of Section 12, a distance of 190.0 feet; thence easterly parallel to said North line, a distance of 245.0 feet; thence southerly parallel to said East line, a distance of 410.0 feet; thence Easterly parallel to said North line, a distance of 200.0 feet to a point on said east line; thence northerly along said east line, a distance of 600.0 feet to the point of beginning.

Section II: The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, is 66 acres, more or less.

Section III. The City Council hereby determines:


- (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Hutchinson and of the territory affected
- (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City Government

Section IV. Therefore, the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section V: This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
