AN ORDINANCE IN-
CORPORATING CERTAIN LANDS
SURROUNDED BY THE CITY OF
HUTCHINSON, MINNESOTA AND
FORMERLY LOCATED IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF LYNN

THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON
DOES ORDAIN:

Section I. The following described
property owned by Ronald Horswell
is completely surrounded by the City
of Hutchinson, Minnesota:

The North 160 feet of the East 150
feet of Lot 19 of Auditor's Plat of that
part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of
Section 1 - T 116 N - R 30 W lying
South of the Mill Pond

Section II. MSA, Section 414.033,
Subdivision 4 provides that "If the
land is completely surrounded by
land within the municipal limits, the
municipal council may by ordinance
declare the land annexed to the
municipality, and any such land is
deemed to be urban in character."

Section III. Therefore, the City of
Hutchinson, Minnesota hereby
ordains and declares that the
property hereinbefore described be
and the same is hereby annexed to,
and included in the City of Hut-
chinson, Minnesota as effectually as
if it had originally been a part
thereof.

Section IV. This ordinance shall be
final and shall take effect and be in
force after filing certified copy
thereof with the Minnesota
Municipal Commission, the County
Auditor and the Secretary of State,
and from and after its passage and
publication.

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Affidavit of Publication

Mills, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The Hutchinson Leader and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a semi-weekly and is distributed at least twice each week. (3) Said newspaper has 25% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Hutchinson in the County of McLeod and it has its known office of issue in the City of Hutchinson, in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.


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
