ORDINANCE NO. 354

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN THE  
TOWNSHIP OF NORTH, PENNINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA  
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINNESOTA

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Whereas the following described lands in the Township of North, County of Pennington and State of Minnesota are more than Sixty Per Cent (60%) bordered by the City of Thief River Falls and Notice of Intent to Annex the same has been served upon the town board of said township as required by law and no objection has been filed within the time specified by statute, the City Council does, therefore, hereby declare the following described lands to be annexed to the City of Thief River Falls, Minnesota:

A tract of land which is part of Park Addition to Thief River Falls, Gov't. Lot 13 and part of Gov't. Lot 12 and part of Gov't. Lot 11 of Section 35, T. 154N, R.43W bounded as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west line of said Section 35 which point lies north a distance of 1074.3' from the southwest corner of said Section 35 which point is the southwesterly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway #59; thence N 12° 50' E a distance of 177.2' to the point of beginning of the tract to be annexed; thence N 56° 14' E a distance of 843'; thence N 15° 38' E to an intersection with the centerline of the Red Lake River; thence northwesterly along the centerline of said river to an intersection with a north-south line which is the east line extended of the west 35' of Lot 1 of Block 4 of said Park Addition; thence South along said east line to the centerline of a vacated street between Lots 2 of Block 4 and Lot 5 of Block 5 all in said Park Addition; thence west along the centerline of said vacated street to an intersection with the centerline of a natural waterway which is the west boundary of said Lot 2 of Block 4; thence northerly along the centerline of said waterway to an intersection with the centerline of the alley between Lots 4 and 5 of Forsberg's Rearrangement of part of Park Addition; thence West along the centerline of said alley to the centerline of Pine Ave.; thence South along the centerline of Pine Ave. to an intersection with the north line extended of Lot 4 of Block 3 of said Park Addition; thence West along said north line of said Lot 4 and Lot 17 to the west line of said Park Addition; thence southeasterly along the westerly line of said Park Addition to the centerline

of First Street; thence East along the centerline of First Street to a point; thence South to a point on the south line of First Street which point lies West along the south line of First Street a distance of 831.45' from the northwest corner of Lot 4 of Block 7 of said Park Addition; thence S8° 43' E a distance of 149.9' to the northeasterly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway #59; thence S 40° 05' E along said right-of-way line a distance of 96.9'; thence N 90° W a distance of 226' to the south line of First Street; thence West along the south line of First Street a distance of 50'; thence North to the southwest corner of Lot 1 of Block 5 of said Park Addition; thence continuing North along the west line of said Lot 1 to the northwest corner thereof; thence East along the north line of said Lot 1 projected to the centerline of Oak Ave.; thence South along the centerline of Oak Ave. to the centerline of First Street; thence East along the centerline of First Street to a point 50' West of the East line of Lot 8 of Block 7 of said Park Addition; thence South along a line parallel to the East line of said Lot 8 a distance of 170'; thence East along a line parallel to the south line of First Street a distance of 200' to the East line of Lot 7, Block 7, said Park Addition; thence South along the East line of said Lot 7 to the undiminished Red Lake Indian Reservation boundary; thence southeasterly along said boundary to a point; thence northeasterly to a point on the northeasterly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway #59 which point lies a distance of 316.5' measured along said right-of-way line from the point of intersection of said right-of-way line and the West line of Lot 4 of Block 7 of said Park Addition; thence N 49° 0' E a distance of 230.9'; thence S 87° 15' E a distance of 214.55' to the East line of Lot 1 of said Block 7 of said Park Addition; thence South along said East line to the point of beginning; containing 75.5 acres more or less.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing of copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of North Township, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
