PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the United States has need of the fullest contributions of all its citizens, and
- WHEREAS, American women constitute an important underutilized source of talents and skills within our Nation and State, and
- WHEREAS, the Woman's Bureau of the U.S. Department of Labor has, since its founding on June 5, 1920, helped the women of our country make increasingly significant contributions to our society as workers, homemakers, and citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 31 through June 6 be set aside to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the founding of the Women's Bureau of the Department of Labor and request that all citizens lend their support to those activities that give recognition to the achievements of the Bureau, the Minnesota Division on Women's Affairs of the Minnesota Department of Human Rights, and to American's Womanpower - A National Resource.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy and of the State the one hundred thirteenth.
