PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Saturday, July 4, 1970, will mark the 194th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence of the United States of America in 1776, and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared July 4, 1970, as "Honor America Day," with special ceremonies in the Nation's Capitol, and

WHEREAS, "Honor America Day" has been organized nationally under a committee headed by Dr. Billy Graham and Bob Hope, with Mrs. Dwight D. Eisenhower and former Presidents Harry S. Truman and Lyndon B. Johnson as honorary co-chairmen, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that Minnesotans join in a re-kindling of the American spirit of patriotism and respect for individual liberties,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of Minnesota, hereby proclaim Saturday, July 4, as

"HONOR AMERICA DAY"

in Minnesota, and I further designate that Mrs. Russell T. (Rhoda) Lund, Edina, Minnesota, be appointed as State Coordinator for "Honor America Day".

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed here at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and of the State, the one hundred thirteenth.
