

ORDINANCE NO. 104AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANNEXATION

The Village Council of Mountain Lake, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Annexed Territory

The following-described territory is hereby annexed to the Village of Mountain Lake, County of Cottonwood, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28) Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Thirty-four (34W) West, Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Westerly on and along the South line of said Section to the Easterly right-of-way line of 10th Street; thence Northwesterly on said Easterly right-of-way line to a point that is Four Hundred Fifty-Two feet and Five inches (452'5⁰⁰N) North, as measured perpendicularly to the South Section line; thence East parallel to said South line to a point that is One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five and Five Tenths feet (1445.5') West, as measured perpendicularly to the East line of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Thirty-Four West (34W), Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Southerly parallel to said East line to a point that is Two Hundred Twenty-six and Five Tenths feet (226.5') North of the South line of said Section Twenty-eight (28); thence Easterly parallel to the South line of said Section to the Northerly extension of the West line of Nickel's Subdivision; thence Southerly on said extension to the North line of Nickel's Subdivision; thence Easterly on the North line of Nickel's Subdivision to the East line of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Hundred Six North (106N); Range Thirty-four West (34W), Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Southerly to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Effective Date

Section 1. Annexed Territory

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Eight (28) Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Thirty-Four West (34W), Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Westerly on and along the South line of said Section to the Easterly right-of-way line of 10th Street; thence Northwesterly on said Easterly right-of-way line to a point that is Four Hundred Fifty-Two feet and five inches (452'5"N) North, as measured perpendicularly to the South Section line; thence East parallel to said South line to a point that is One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five and Five Tenths feet (1445.5') West, as measured perpendicularly to the East line of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Thirty-Four West (34W), Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Southerly parallel to said East line to a point that is Two Hundred Twenty-Six and Five Tenths feet (226.5) North of the South line of said Section Twenty-Eight; thence Easterly parallel to the South line of said Section to the Northerly extension of the West line of Nickel's Subdivision; thence Southerly on said extension to the North line of Nickel's Subdivision; thence Easterly on the North line of Nickel's Subdivision to the East line of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Thirty-Four West (34W), Cottonwood County, Minnesota; thence Southerly to the point of beginning.
