KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, DOUGLAS M. HEAD, Attorney

General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes, Section 8.06, and upon the request of the Board of Trustees of the Public Employees Retirement Fund, the Board of Trustees of the State Employees Retirement Fund, and the Board of Trustees of the Teachers Retirement Association, do hereby constitute and appoint

MERWIN W. PETERSON

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) per annum, to be paid from and out of the respective funds aforementioned, as follows: 40 percent of said amount to be paid from and out of the Public Employees Retirement Fund, 30 percent of said amount to be paid from and out of the State Employees Retirement Fund and 30 percent of said amount to be paid from and out of the Teachers Retirement Association. Said MERWIN W. PETERSON shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; provided, however, that any of said boards, by majority vote, may terminate its obligation to pay the compensation hereinbefore stated. Said appointment shall take effect July 1, 1970.
