AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ESTABLISHED DATE FOR THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION.

The Village Council of Biscay, Minnesota Does Ordain:

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 205.07, commencing with the 1970 Village election, that the regular village election of Biscay Village shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication. Adopted by the council this 14th day of July, 1970.

Voting for passage of this ordinance were councilmen Chelin, Mc Guire and Moehring and clerk Osmeck. There were no votes against so the ordinance was ordered adopted and published.
