

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. Petitions have been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following real estate, to have such property included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

A tract of land in the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄) of Section 13, Township 102 North, Range 40 West, described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section 13; thence running north on the west line of said Section 13 a distance of 1,897 feet; thence east and parallel with the south line of said Section 13 a distance of 360 feet to the point of beginning; thence east and parallel with the south line of said Section 13 a distance of 160.0 feet; thence north on the west line of Darling's First Addition a distance of 640 feet to the Northwest corner of Darling's First Addition; thence east on the north line of Darling's First Addition a distance of 360.0 feet; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Section 13 a distance of 70 feet; thence east and parallel with the south line of said Section 13 a distance of 162.5 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of said Section 13 a distance of 640 feet; thence west and parallel with the south line of said Section 13 a distance of 662.3 feet; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Section 13 a distance of 610.0 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described is 7.68 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Redden County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on June 26, 1970, that said petition was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein does upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
