Ordinance No. 189

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HERON LAKE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The Village Council of the Village of Heron Lake Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Village Council of the Village of Heron Lake, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the Village of Heron Lake, Minnesota:

A tract of land in the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼), of Section (20), Township One-Hundred-Four (104) North, Range Thirty Seven (37) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Jackson County Minnesota described as follows to wit:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Hanson's Second Addition to the Village of Heron Lake; thence East a distance of 653.40 feet; thence South along a line and parallel with the East line of Hanson's Addition, a distance of 1070.00 feet; thence West a distance of 653.40 feet, to the East line of Hanson's Addition to the Village of Heron Lake at the South line of Second Street in said Village; thence North along the East line of Hanson's Addition, a distance of 1070.00 feet, to the place of beginning.

Section 2. The quantify of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 16.05 acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Heron Lake, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Weimer Township, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.

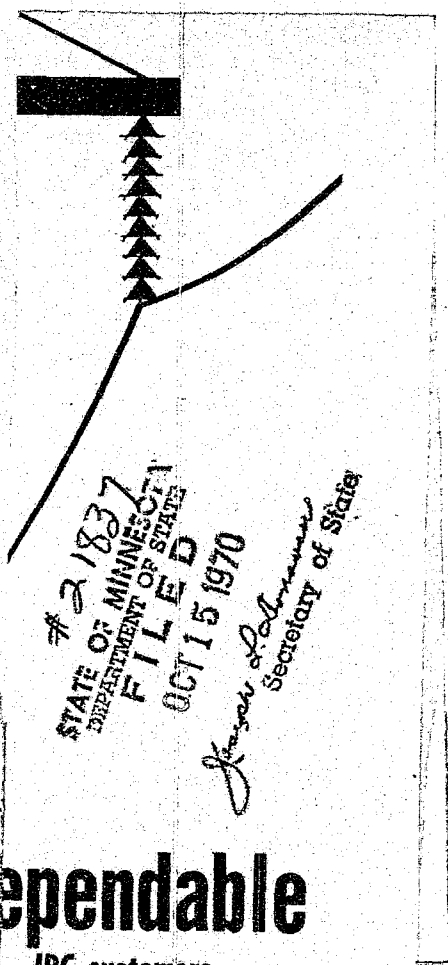


