
Gentlemen:

ORDINANCE NO. 10-15  
AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE  
DATE FOR REGULAR ELEC-  
TIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF  
MIDDLE RIVER.

The council of the Village of  
Middle River Ordains:

1. The date of the annual elec-  
tion of the Village of Middle  
River elective officials shall be  
the first Tuesday after the First  
Monday of November of each  
year, commencing with the elec-  
tion to be held during the calen-  
dar year, 1970.

2. The designated judges for  
Federal, State and/or County  
elections held at the same time  
and place in the village shall  
serve as judges for the village  
election.

3. The regular annual village  
election shall be held with the  
Village Fire Hall (Councilrooms)  
as the singular voting location  
in the village of Middle River.

4. This ordinance shall be pub-  
lished following passage and take  
effect and be in force from and  
after July 16, 1970.
