- WHEREAS, more than 100,000 of our citizens live in mobile homes; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota has become a major manufacturer of mobile homes to the Upper Midwest; and
- WHEREAS, the mobile home industry is clearly an important segment of our life and economy in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS, these good citizens comprise a section of all vocations, including students of higher learning; doctors, attorneys, executives, skilled and unskilled workers, and senior citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 22 through 28, 1970 as

MOBILE HOME WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark it well.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and of the State, the one hundred twelfth.
