PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, it is through the assimilation of many national groups and diverse cultures that Minnesota has formed a strong and vigorous society, and;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Minnesota Federation of Croatian Lodges is to keep the Croatian traditions alive and to help the younger generation to understand the customs, dance, music, and language, and;

WHEREAS, through such annual celebrations can be created a spirit of fraternalism and pride amongst our people for their heritage and recognition of the fact that such spirit has much to offer America in the years to come;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 6, 1970, as

ANNUAL CROATIAN DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all of our citizens to mark this observance, paying tribute to the outstanding contribution made by the people of Croatian descent in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and of the State, the one hundred thirteenth.
