PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the pharmacists of the State of Minnesota are health professionals safeguarding and promoting the well-being of our citizens, and
- WHEREAS, these pharmacists give wholeheartedly of their time and talents to assure that pharmaceutical services and guidance are available to all, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota pharmacists have actively participated in programs to minimize improper drug use, and
- WHEREAS, National Pharmacy Week, under the auspices of the American Pharmaceutical Association, will be observed nationally during the week of October 4-10, 1970, to direct public attention to the need to "Respect Medicines", the theme of this year's observance, and
- WHEREAS, the safe, effective use of medicines depends upon the physician, patient, and pharmacist working together so that today's medicines can benefit the human body, not damage it,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 4 - 10, 1970, as

PHARMACY WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize this week the services of our pharmacists, and to consult with them about the safe, effective use of today's medicines.
