PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is engaged in an extensive program to upgrade its highway system to meet the needs of its people and of a growing economy, and;
- WHEREAS, there is a shortage of funds affecting much needed highway construction, and due to the need to insure the inviolability of the Highway Trust Fund, and;
- WHEREAS, this program will assure safer, more convenient travel for all motorists, and more efficient movement of the goods and services upon which modern life depends, and;
- WHEREAS, the motorists of Minnesota support this program through their highway-use taxes, and should take every opportunity to inform themselves of the progress and planning in highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 20-26 as

HIGHWAY WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to reflect upon the motto for the week which is "Highways Serve You".
