PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the American Production and Inventory Control Society, Inc., was organized in Cleveland in 1957, and;
- WHEREAS, the international professional society composed of persons in Production and Inventory Control Management has flourished over the years and has now attained over 85000 members in over 127 Chapters in the United States, one territory and ten international affiliates, and;
- WHEREAS, the primary objective of Production and Inventory Control Management is to exercise continuous control over all phases of material flow both into and out of each manufacturing concern. With the passing of the annual inventory of the early eras manufacturers are now able to stabilize control of output and inflow and thus enabled to establish smooth working relations with their producers and with the distributors of each of their own products, and;
- WHEREAS, the National-International Organization has scheduled its 13th Annual and Technical Exhibit in Cincinnati, Ohio, October 7, 8, and 9, 1970;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of October 7, 8, and 9, 1970, as
