PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, he has devoted his artistic power and musical intelligence to the development and flowering of the great Minnesota Orchestra for a complete decade--one of the most significant periods in the long history of the orchestra, and

WHEREAS, under his direction the orchestra, long one of our State's greatest resources, has become a truly regional institution, bringing the satisfaction of fine music, often for the first time, to many thousands of residents of Minnesota and neighboring states, and

WHEREAS, he begins his 11th season as conductor of the Orchestra with the celebration of a major event in its long life: the beginning of a permanent full series of concerts in St. Paul, which will make the orchestra's principal work available to many thousands of new music lovers, and

WHEREAS, he has been a symbol in our community of refusal to compromise with the limitations of mass produced culture and of total striving toward the most human and personal forms of artistic endeavor, and

WHEREAS, during his tenure he has increased the already illustrious reputation of the Minnesota Orchestra and through it, of the State of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October to honor the achievements of

STANISLAW SKROWACZEWSKI

Music Director of the Minnesota Orchestra and to recognize with gratitude the value of his important contributions to the State of Minnesota and to the quality of its citizens' lives.
