Dear Sir:-

You will please take notice that the undersigned, will, within 30 days, file an application in the General Land Office, at Washington, D. C., for the survey of a certain unsurveyed island in Barw's Lake, lying in the eastern part of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of SW<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec. 22, and in the western part of the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of SW<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec. 25, Township 53 North, Range 15 West, 4th P.M., St. Louis County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Section line between Sections 22 and 25, 3.94 chains south from M.C. No. 8; thence at an angle of 92° westerly 2.77 chains; thence at a deflection to the left at an angle of 153° 15' 2.31 chains to a point; thence at a deflection of 29° 45' to the left 1.30 chains to a point on said Section line; thence north along said Sec. line 2.10 chains to the point of beginning, all in Sec. 22. Also starting from same point on said Section line 3.94 chains south of M.C. No. 8, a deflection of 88° to the left 0.91 chains to a point; thence at a deflection of 42° to the right 5.42 chains to a point; thence at a deflection of 102° to the right 0.84 chains to a point; thence at a deflection of 49° to the right 1.96 chains to a point; thence at a deflection of 22° 30' to the right 2.79 chains to a point on said Section line; thence north along said Sec. line 2.10 chains to the point of beginning, all in Section 25, containing approximately 1.30 acres in all.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
