ORDINANCE NO. 6-8

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE
INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, certain Petitions, dated the 14th day of May, 1970, and the 7th day of July, 1970, requesting annexation to the Village of Watertown of certain territory described below, was duly presented to the Village Council of the Village of Watertown on the 7th day July, 1970, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.033; and

WHEREAS, The Village Council finds that said Petitions were signed by all of the owners of said lands and are suitable and proper in all respects; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petitions were duly forwarded on the 17th day of August, 1970, to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Township of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law and rules of the Minnesota Municipal Commission; and

WHEREAS, more than 60 days have elapsed since the date of said filings and no objections have been made in writing, or otherwise, to the Village of Watertown as to the annexation proposed by said Petition:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that a copy of said Petitions were duly mailed as required by law and the rules and regulations of the Minnesota Municipal Commission to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and that no objection of the proposed annexation has been made by any of said parties or filed with the Village Council and that the territory described below abuts upon the present corporate limits of the Village of Watertown; that said lands do not exceed 200 acres in area; that said lands are not now included in any other municipalities; that said lands are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government; and that annexation of said lands would be to the best interest of the Village of Watertown and the Territory to be annexed.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Watertown are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory as described and set forth on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law.

EXHIBIT "A"

Outlots 54, 55, 56 according to the original plat of the Townsite of Watertown, EXCEPTING therefrom the following described parcels of land:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Outlot 55; running thence Northerly 8 rods; thence Westerly parallel with the South line of said Outlot 55, 17 rods; thence Southerly 8 rods to the South line of said Outlot 55; thence Easterly along the South line of said Outlot 55, 10 rods to the place of beginning, containing one-half acre.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Outlot 56; running thence Northerly 76 feet 4 inches; thence Westerly parallel with the South line of said Outlot 56, 160 feet; thence Southerly 76 feet 4 inches to the South line of said Outlot 56; thence Easterly along the South line of said Outlot 56 160 feet to the place of beginning.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Outlot 56; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of Outlot 56, 76 feet 4 inches to a point on the Easterly line of Outlot 56 to the point of beginning; thence Northwesterly parallel with the South line of Outlot 56, 160 feet to a point 76 feet 4 inches Northerly of the South line of Outlot 56; thence Southerly 76 feet 4 inches to a point on the Southerly line of Outlot 56, 160 feet Westerly of the Southeast corner of Outlot 56; thence Westerly on the South line of Outlot 56, 40 feet; thence Northerly 152 feet 8 inches to a point 200 feet Westerly of the East line of Outlot 56; thence Easterly parallel with the Northerly line of Outlot 56, 200 feet to a point 152 feet 8 inches from the Southeast corner of Outlot 56; thence Southerly 76 feet 4 inches to the place of beginning.

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Outlot 54; thence Northwesterly on the Northerly line of Outlot 54, 200 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly 132 feet to a point 200 feet Northwesterly of the Easterly line of said Outlot 54; thence Southeasterly 200 feet parallel with the Northerly line of said Outlot 54 to the Easterly line of Outlot 54; thence Northeasterly 132 feet to the place of beginning.

Commencing at a point on the Easterly line of Outlot 54 which is 132 feet Southwesterly of the Northeast corner thereof; thence Northwesterly parallel to the Northerly line of said Outlot 54 a distance of 200 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly parallel to the Easterly line of said Outlot 54 a distance of 150 feet to a point; thence Southeasterly parallel to the Northerly line of Outlot 55 a distance of 200 feet to a point on the Easterly line of Outlot 55; thence Northeasterly along the Easterly line of Outlots 55 and 54 a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning.

Commencing at a point on the Northerly line of Outlot 54 which is 200 feet Northwesterly of the Northeast corner thereof; thence Northwesterly along said Northerly line a distance of 200 feet to

the Northwest corner of said Outlot 54; thence Southwesterly along the Westerly line of said Outlot 54 a distance of 150 feet to a point; thence Southeasterly parallel to the Northerly line of said Outlot 54 a distance of 200 feet to a point; thence Northeasterly parallel to the Easterly line of said Outlot 54 a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning.

Commencing at the Northeasterly corner of outlot 75, Village of Watertown and running 116 feet Northwesterly along the boundary of Outlot 75, then Southwesterly 280.5 feet to the Southernmost boundary of Outlot 75, then Southeasterly 116 feet to the Easternmost boundary, then Northeasterly 280.5 feet to the place of beginning.

Commencing at the Northeastern corner of Outlot 74, Village of Watertown, and running 116 feet Northwesterly along the boundary of Outlot 74, then Southwesterly 280.5 feet to the Southernmost boundary of Outlot 74, then Southeasterly 116 feet to the Easternmost boundary, then Northeasterly 280.5 feet to the place of the beginning.

Commencing at the Northeastern corner of Outlot 73, Village of Watertown and running 116 feet Northwesterly along the boundary of Outlot 73, then Southwesterly 103 feet, then Southeasterly 116 feet to the Eastern boundary, then Northwesterly to the place of beginning.

Part of Outlots 57 and 58, of the Village of Watertown, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County and State, described as follows: Commencing at the most northerly corner of Outlot 57; thence Southwesterly along the Northwesterly line of said Outlots 57 and 58 a distance of 260 feet to a point; thence Southeasterly, parallel to the Northeasterly line of said Outlot 58 a distance of 196.5 feet, more or less, to a point; thence Northeasterly, parallel to the Northwesterly line of said Outlots 57 and 58 a distance of 260 feet, more or less, to a point in the Northeasterly line of said Outlot 57; thence Northwesterly along the Northeasterly line of said Outlot 57 a distance of 196.5 feet to the place of beginning.

Also that part of Jackson Street lying between Carver County Highway No. 25 and the centerline of White Street; also the Northeasterly 33 feet of White Street lying between the Northwesterly line of Jackson Street and the Southeasterly line of Carver County Highway No. 25.

All of the above described property being situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 117, Range 25.

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Honorable Village Council of Watertown:

The undersigned Petitioner hereby respectfully represents
and states:

The undersigned Petitioner desires and requests that certain
lands be annexed to the Village of Watertown, Carver County, Minn-
esota, and included within its Corporate Limits, said lands being
more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Part of Outlots 57 and 58, of the Village of Watertown,
Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of
record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for
said County and State, described as follows: Commencing
at the most northerly corner of Outlot 57; thence South-
westerly along the Northwesterly line of said Outlots 57
and 58 a distance of 260 feet to a point; thence South-
easterly, parallel to the Northeasterly line of said Out-
lot 58 a distance of 196.6 feet, more or less, to a point;
thence Northeasterly, parallel to the Northwesterly line
of said Outlots 57 and 58 a distance of 260 feet, more or
less, to a point in the Northeasterly line of said Out-
lot 57; thence Northwesterly along the Northeasterly line
of said Outlot 57 a distance of 196.5 feet to the place of
beginning. Also that part of Jackson Street lying between Carver County
Highway No. 25 and the centerline of White Street; also the Northeasterly
33 feet of White Street lying between the Northwesterly line of Jackson
Street and the southeasterly line of Carver County Highway No. 25. Said
land for annexation exclusive of streets containing approx 1.1 acres more or
less.

That the undersigned Petitioner is the owner of the said lands
herein described which are proposed to be annexed to the Village of
Watertown.

That the said above described lands abut the present Corporate
Limits of the Village of Watertown; that the area proposed to be annex-
ed does not exceed 200 acres in area; and that said lands are not now
included in any other municipality.

That your Petitioner verily believes that said lands are con-
ditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government and that
such annexation would be to the best interests of the Village of Water-
town and of the above described lands proposed to be annexed.

That the undersigned Petitioner makes this Petition to the Honor-
able Village Council of the Village of Watertown, Carver County, Minnesota,
in accordance with and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.03
and prays that the Village Council of the Village of Watertown will grant
this Petition, and will take any and all action necessary for annexation
of the above described lands under the authority granted by said Section
