ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UN-PLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES, PURSUANT TO M.S.A. SECTION 414.041, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

A petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, by Donald C. Veroeven, as owner of the following described real estate, to have such lands included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

South 381.2 feet of the East 12 acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW%) of the Southeast Quarter (SE%) of Section 8, Township 108 North, Range 26 West, Blue Earth County, Minnesota.

II.

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits of any city or village and is contiguous to and abutting upon a portion of the northeasterly part of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, an incorporated city, having a population of not less than 10,000 nor more than 30,000, pursuant to the last census. That it appears from the records of the Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for annexation were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Mankato Township Town Board, and the Blue Earth County Board, and that the sixty day period as provided for by Section 414.041 of M.S.A., and the Rules of the Municipal Commission, having been duly waived by the Mankato Township Board, Blue Earth County Board and the City of Mankato, and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

III.

The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tracts and parcels of land are so conditioned as to be subjected to city government and are hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the City of Mankato, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota are hereby extended to include said property.
