
OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Public Welfare, do hereby constitute and appoint

JUDY OAKES

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Public Welfare, and fix her compensation in the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) per annum, to be paid from and out of the funds of said Department. Said JUDY OAKES shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on January 4, 1971.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 4th day of January, 1971.




