KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS,

Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the
authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of
Minnesota Statutes, Section 8.02, do hereby constitute and appoint

THOMAS B. SEDGWICK

of Bloomington, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General,
for the purpose of providing legal services for the Securities
Division of the Department of Commerce and such other matters as
the Attorney General may assign. He shall serve at the pleasure
of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked
or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix
the compensation of said THOMAS B. SEDGWICK at the sum of Twelve
Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) per annum, to be paid from the appropria-
tion made for the Department of Commerce. Said appointment shall
take effect on January 4, 1971.
