

SUBJECT: GLENDALE SAVAGE I-24m

On December 24, 1968, the Municipal Commission issued its order consolidating the Village of Savage with the Town of Glendale excepting Sections 30 and 31 of the Town. At the time this order was issued the Municipal Commission did not have the authority to establish populations for the distribution of state aids. This authority was granted to the Commission by the 1969 Legislature and became effective on June 10, 1969.

Subsequent to the issuance of the above order the Municipal Commission was ordered by the District Court to amend its order by adding Section 30 and 31 to the new Village of Savage. The amendment was issued on the 23rd day of June, 1970.

Although the amended order was issued after June 10, 1969, it is the judgment of the Commission that the law which was in effect when the original order was issued governs the proceeding. Accordingly, no provision was included for establishing the population of the new Village of Savage. The procedures used before June 10, 1969, should be used by the Secretary of State and the auditor in this case.
