TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF WASECA IN THE STATE OF
MINNESOTA:

The undersigned hereby petition you to call an election
for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the
Village of Waldorf in the County of Waseca and State of Minnesota
and for the purpose of so petitioning you hereby state:

1- That the boundaries of the territory which the under-
signed hereby petition you to incorporate and propose to incor-
porate and the description thereof is as follows:

The West half of the Northeast Quarter and the
East Half of the Northwest Quarter of section three
Township one hundred five, Range twenty-four in
Waseca County, Minnesota; also the southeast quarter
of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the
southeast quarter of section thirty four township one
hundred six Range twenty-four in Waseca County Minnesota.

the boundaries thereof being as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the southeast quarter
of the southwest quarter of section 34 Township 106 Range 24, thence
south in a straight line 240 rods to the southwest corner of the
east half of the northwest quarter of section three Township 105

Resolution

Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Waseca County, Minnesota:

Whereas 31 of the voters residing within the territory in said petition described have petitioned this board to call an election for the proposed incorporation of the Village of Waldorf, and whereas it appears to this board that 31 legal voters residing in the territory described in said petition have signed and made and presented said petition and it further appearing that on September 14th 1920 the petitioners caused a census of the resident population of the territory described in said petition to be taken as provided by law and that at the time of the taking of said census said territory had and now is a population of 131 and whereas said petition sets forth the boundaries of the territory sought to be incorporated, the quantity of land embraced therein and that the number of actual residents therein is 131 and the proposed name of said Village is "Waldorf"; and whereas said petition is verified by the oaths of three of said petitioners and is in all respects in due form of law and contains all the matters and things required by law to be set forth therein.

Now therefore it is ordered that said petition be and it hereby is in all things approved and it is further ordered that an election be held in the territory described in said petition on the 18th day of November 1920 between the hours of 9 A.M. and 9 P.M. at the fire hall in Waldorf in said territory for the determination of said proposed incorporation. That W. A. Pofahl, Peter Deneffe and John Hickey who are residents of said territory are hereby appointed inspectors to act as Judges of said election and they shall conduct the same as far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers. Only voters residing within said territory shall be entitled to vote. The ballot shall bear the words "For Incorporation -Yes-No" with a square after each of the last two words in one of which the voter shall make a cross to express his choice. After such election the inspectors shall file the certificate required by law with the

County Auditor.

It is further ordered that a copy of said petition together with a notice of the time and place of holding such election as hereinbefore provided be posted in these public places within the boundaries described in said petition and the board further finds as a fact that there is no newspaper published within the limits described in said petition.

CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTORS

The undersigned W. A. Pofahl, Peter Denoffe and John Hickey, who are the inspectors appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Essex County, Minnesota by its resolution duly adopted October 18th, 1920, do hereby certify:

That on the 18th day of November, 1920 between the hours of nine o'clock a.m. and nine o'clock p.m. at the Fire Hall in Waldorf in the territory described in the petition for Incorporation in the above entitled matter, an election for the determination of said proposed incorporation of said territory described in said petition as the Village of Waldorf, was held all in accordance with said resolutions of said Board of County Commissioners and said election was held at the time and place hereinbefore and in said resolution specified.

That at said election only legal voters residing within said territory described in said petition voted and said election was conducted in the way and manner provided by law and as provided in said resolution of said Board of County Commissioners.
