PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, It appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the last general election November 2nd, 1920, for and against a proposition known as Chapter 533 of the Session Laws of 1919, known as an Act to Amend Section 2326, General Statutes of 1913, relating to the taxation of railroad companies owning or operating any line of railroad situate within or partly within this state, that a majority of all the electors voting at such election voted for the adoption of said proposition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joseph A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the power in me vested, do hereby publish and proclaim that the proposition to amend Section 2236, General Statutes of 1913, relating to the taxation of railroad companies owning or operating any line of railroad situate within or partly within this state, has been ratified and adopted in the manner prescribed by the Constitution and laws of the State.
