PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Minnesota, by Chapter 530 of the Session Laws of 1919, has proposed an amendment to be known as Article Sixteen (16) of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, providing for and establishing a trunk highway system to be constructed, improved, and maintained by the State, and establishing and authorizing the creation of a fund for such purpose by the taxation of motor vehicles, the issuance of bonds, and otherwise; and,

WHEREAS, It appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the last general election November 2nd for and against the aforesaid Constitutional amendment made in conformity with the law that a majority of all the electors voting at such election voted for its adoption; and,

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Minnesota by Chapter 531 of the Session Laws of 1919 has proposed an amendment to Section Seven (7), Article Six (6) of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, changing the length of the term of the Judge of the Probate Court; and,

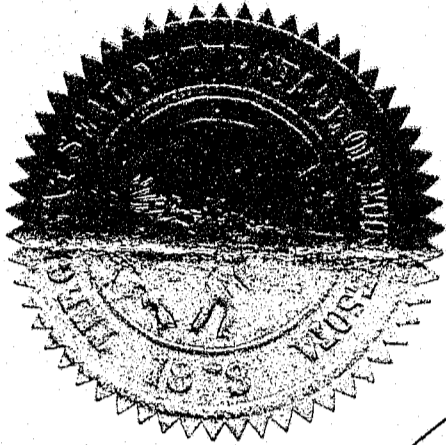
WHEREAS, It appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the last general election November 2nd for and against the aforesaid Constitutional amendment made in conformity with the law that a majority of all the electors voting at such election voted for its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joseph A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the power vested in me and in compliance with the law, do hereby publish and proclaim that the proposed amendment to be known as Article Sixteen (16) of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota and the proposed amendment to Section Seven (7), Article Six (6) of the Con-

stitution of the State of Minnesota has each been ratified and adopted as prescribed by the Constitution and laws of this state.
