ORDINANCE NO. 38
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 161 North, RANGE 47 WEST to the VILLAGE OF LAKE BRONSON ${ }_{9}$ MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF LAKE BRONSON ORDAINS:
Section 1. That the following property shall be annexed
pursuant to M.S.A. 414.033 to the Village of Lake Bronson,
Minnesota:
All that part of the Northeast one-quarter of the southeast one-quarter ( $\mathrm{NE} \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twentyfive (25), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North, Range Forty-seven (47) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast One-Quarter of the Southeast onemquarter (NE $\frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE}_{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of said Section(25) Twenty-five, the point of beginning; thence north along the east line of said Section Twenty-five (25), a distance of 342.5 feet to a point; thence west parallel with the south line of said Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast onequarter ( $\mathrm{NE} \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twentyfive (25), a distance of 1,000 feet to a point; thence at right angles south to a point on the high bank of the Two Rivers river; thence southeasterly along the easterly high bank of the Two Rivers river to a point on the south line of the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Section Twenty-five (25) (which point is approximately 55 rods west of the southeast corner of said Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast onequarter ( $\mathrm{NE}_{\frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4} \text { ) of Section Twenty-five (25); thence }}$ eastalong the south line of the Northeast onemuarter of the Southeas onemquarter ( $\mathrm{NE}_{4} \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-five (25), a distance of about 907.5 feet ( 55 rods) to the point of beginning; excepting a tract previously annexed to the Village of Lake Bronson which is described as follows:

A tract in the Northeast onemuarter of the Southeast one-quarter ( $N E \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North, Range Forty-seven (47) West, described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one -quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE( $\frac{11}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161), Range Forty-seven (47), thence due west on the line between the north onehalf and the south one -half of said Southeast onequarter ( $\mathrm{SE} \frac{1}{4}$ ), a distance of 20 rods, thence due north a distance of 5 rods, thence due east, parallel to the line between the north one-half and the south one-half of the said Southeast one quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), a distance of 20 rods, thence due south on Section line between Sections Twenty-five (25) and Thirty (30), a distance of 5 rods to point of beginning containing 100 square rods.

The above described tract contains 6.87 acres, more or less.

Section 2. That it will be to the best interests of the
Village of Lake Bronson, Minnesota, and the territory affected that such land be annexed to the Village of Lake Bronson, Minnesota.

Section 3. That said annexation shall be effective upon the publication of this Ordinance, and filing required by Law.

All part of the Northeast onequarter of the southeast onequarter (NE 1/4SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township one Hundred Sixty-one (161) North, Range Forty-seven (47) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows:
Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast OneQuarter of the Southeast onequarter (NE 1/4SE 1/4) of said Section (25) Twenty-five, the point of beginning; thence north along the east line of said Section Twenty-ftve (25), a distance of 342.5 feet to a point; thence west parallel with the south line of said Northeastone-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE $1 / 4$ SE I/4) of Section Twenty-five (25), a distance of 1,000 feet to a point; thence at right angles south to a point on the high bank of the Two Rivers river; thence southeasterly along the easterly high bank of the Two Rivers river to a point on the
