ORDINANCE NO. 382

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON AND ANNEXING THERETO CERTAIN LAND FORMERLY LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LYNN

THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON DOES ORDAIN:

Section I: A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota by Sioux Enterprises, Inc., for Sioux Second Addition by petitioners, Howard Quade, Jr., Harry R. Hanson, Milton A. Brinkman and Ralph D. Westlund, being one hundred percent sole owners of the following described real property, to have said property annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Hutchinson, County of McLeod, State of Minnesota, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the North line of Lot 91, Lynn Addition, 823.0 feet West of the Northeast corner of Lot 91; thence South parallel to the East line of said lot 91, a distance of 468.0 feet; thence East Parallel to said North line, a distance of 158.0 feet; thence South parallel to said East line, a distance of 854.77 feet; to a point in the South line of Lot 91; thence west along said South line, a distance of 667.07 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 91; thence North along the West line of Lot 91, a distance of 1328.20 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 91; thence East along said North Line a distance of 509.20 feet to the point of beginning, containing 18.65 acres.

Section II: The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, is 18.65 adres.

Section III. The City Council hereby determines:

- (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Hutchinson and of the territory affected
- (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City Government

Section IV: Therefore, the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section V: This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
