

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF AUDITOR'S LOT 3 OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 21, PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO THE VILLAGE OF HINCHEY

The Village Council of Hinchley ordains:

Section I. WHEREAS, Edward Kraschel and Jeanne Kraschel, Husband and Wife, are the owners of the following described premises located in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of Auditor's Lot Three (3), of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Forty-one (41), Range Twenty-one (21), described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast Corner of said Lot 3, thence South along the East line of said Lot 3 a distance of 100', thence West at right angles a distance of 150', thence North at right angles a distance of 114.83', to the southerly line of Polson Avenue (according to the plat on file and of record in the Pine County Register of Deeds Office of Polson's Addition) thence South-easterly along said southerly line of Polson Avenue a distance of 100.0' to the point of beginning.

Section II. WHEREAS, said above described premises are completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits of the Village of Hinchley, and said premises are not included in any other municipality.


Section III. WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Hinchley finds that annexation of the above described premises to the Village of Hinchley is to the best interests of the Village of Hinchley and of the premises affected.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, That the Village Council of the Village of Hinchley, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated 414.023, Subd. 4, does hereby annex said above described premises and lands to the Village of Hinchley, and the Clerk of the Village Council of the Village of Hinchley is hereby directed to forthwith send copies of this Ordinance to the Minnesota Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Town Clerk of the Township of Hinchley, the Pine County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.




