CHAPTER III

ORDINANCE NO. 190 - B

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SARTELL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BOUNDED ON THREE SIDES BY LAND WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND ADJOINING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough and,
WHEREAS the territory described below is bounded on three sides by lands already within the corporate limits of the village of Sartell and is deemed to be urban in character; and, a notice of intent to amend was served upon the Town Board of Saint Rapids Township, Benton County, Minnesota, on the 6th day of October, 1970, and more than 60 days has elapsed since the service of said notice and no objection has been received from the town board; and,
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SARTELL, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

The VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SARTELL, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory Amended. The corporate limits of the Village of Sartell, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unincorporated territory described as follows:

"The Northeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (1/4 Sec 51), excepting therefrom the Southwest Quarter of said 1/4 Sec 51, all in Section Ten (10), Township Thirty-Six (36) Range Thirty-Six (36), Benton County, Minnesota, containing 30 acres; AND that part of Southwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter (1/4 Sec 51) lying North of Village Limits, excepting therefrom the South 16 Rods of North 24 Rods of said 1/4 Sec 51, all in Section Ten (10), Township Thirty-Six (36) Range Thirty-Six (36), Benton County, Minn., containing 14 acres, more or less."

Said territory being zoned under Village Zoning Classification of R - 1
Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Benton County Auditor, the Township of Saint Rapids and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Amendment. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as herein directed.
