

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UN-
INCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEED-

and symbol "South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$)" and

In line five by deleting the word "forty" and substituting
in lieu thereof the word "eighty".

ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES, PURSUANT TO M.S.A. SECTION 414.03, SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

1. A Petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, by Alphonse Trip of the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, as the owner of the following described property to have each and every parcel included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of Section Seventeen (17), in Township One Hundred Eight (108) North of Range Twenty Six (26) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which lies East of the center of the Highway running through said forty, known as "Agency Road", except therefrom any Highway thereon and except 17.71 Acres of the State of Minnesota on which is located the Minnesota Highway Department Building, said tract to be annexed containing 4.73 Acres.

2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits of any city or village and is contiguous to and adjoining upon a portion of the southeasterly boundary of the City of Mankato, Minnesota; and is bounded on the North by Hoffman Beach, on the West by Agency Road and on the East by Trunk Highway No. 22. That said City of Mankato, Minnesota is an incorporated city, having a population of not less than 10,000 nor more than 25,000 persons to the last census. That it appears from the records of the Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for annexation were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Mankato Township Town Board, and the Blue Earth County Board, and that more than thirty days have elapsed since said filing and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

3. The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tracts or parcels of land are so conditioned as to be subjected to city government and are hereby conveyed to and declared to be an addition to the City of Mankato, as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include said property.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and this ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication and upon the filing of certified copies, as herein determined.

- (4) So made up that at least twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve, that it contained general news, comment and miscellany, that it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and that it was not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements;
- (5) Circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office;
- (6) Daily qualified as a medium of official and legal publication.

That there is on file in the office of the County Auditor of said Blue Earth County an affidavit by the publisher and printer in charge of the said newspaper, who had knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that the following is a printed copy of the upper and lower case alphabet from a to z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and

publication of said notice

SECTION 414.03, SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

I.

A Petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota by Alphonse Trio of the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, as the owner of the following described property to have such land included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seventeen (17), in Township One Hundred Eight (108) North in Range Twenty-six (26) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which lies East of the center of the Highway running through said forty, known as "Agency Road", except therefrom any highway thereon and except 17.71 Acres of the State of Minnesota on which is located the Minnesota Highway Department Building. That it appears from the records of the Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for annexation were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Mankato Township Town Board, and the Blue Earth County Board, and that more than thirty days have elapsed since said filing and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

III.

The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tracts or parcels of land are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government and are hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the City of Mankato, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota are hereby extended to include said property.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and this ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication and upon the filing of certified copies, as herein described.
