- Has compiled with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of pub-lication mentioned below.
- Has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 there-after an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by an authorized official and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1.5

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF AITKIN, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED AND/ OR UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 17, 1970, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 27day of <u>April</u>, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described as approximately 60 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by <u>31</u> owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of approximately 100 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Aitkin, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after proper notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the east and south boundaries thereof;

The Council of the Village of Aitkin, Minnesota, ordains:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the village of of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby

part thereof:

All of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¹/₄ of NW¹/₄) lying and being North of the South right-of-way line of the Northern Pacific Railroad right-of-way as said right-of-way now exists; All of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¹/₄ of NW), lying South of the existing Aitkin Village limits; All of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄), except that portion thereof described as follows; commencing at the southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄); running thence North Two Hundred Twenty-seven (227) feet; thence West Five Hundred Seventy-five (575) feet; thence South Two Hundred Twenty-seven (227) feet; thence East Five Hundred Seventy-five (575) feet; all in Section Twenty-five (25), Township Forty-seven (47), Range Twenty-seven (27).

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified

copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of

State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage

and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
