ORDINANCE NO. 155
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF AITKIN, MIN-
NESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED PLATTED
AND/OR UNPLATTED LAND NOT
EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA
ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE
LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition
dated April 17, 1970, requesting
the annexation of the territory
hereinafter described was duly
presented to the council on the
27 day of April, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of
land embraced within the area
described in the petition and
bounded as described as approxi-
mately 60 acres of unplatted
land, no part of which is includ-
ed within the limits of an in-
corporated city, village, or bor-
ough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was
signed by 31 owners, constituting
a majority but not all of a total
number of approximately 100
owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to
the annexation have been re-
ceived from the town board,
the county board, or the gov-
erning body of any municipality
whose boundaries abut upon the
boundaries of the land to be
annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was
duly held by the governing body
of the Village of Aitkin, Minne-
sota, on the proposed annexation
after proper notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described
in the petition abuts upon the
village limits at the east and
south boundaries thereof;

The Council of the Village of
Aitkin, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1. The Village Coun-
cil hereby determines (1) that
the annexation will be to the
best interest of the village of the
territory affected; (2) that the
territory described herein abuts
upon the village limits and is
urban or suburban in character;
and (3) that none of said ter-
ritory is now included within the
limits of any city, village or
borough.

SECTION 2. TERRITORY AN-
NEXED. The corporate limits of
the village are hereby extended
to include the unplatted land
described as follows and the
same is hereby annexed to in-
clude within the village as ef-
fectually as if it had originally
been a part thereof:

All of the Northeast Quarter of
the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
NW $\frac{1}{4}$) lying and being North of
the South right-of-way line of the
Northern Pacific Railroad right-
of-way as said right-of-way now
exists;

All of the Southeast Quarter of
the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
NW $\frac{1}{4}$), lying South of the existing
Aitkin Village limits;

All of the Northeast Quarter of
the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
SW $\frac{1}{4}$), except that portion there-
of described as follows: com-
mencing at the southeast corner
of said Northeast Quarter of
Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$);
running thence Two Hundred
Twenty-seven (227) feet;
thence West Five Hundred Sev-
enty-five (575) feet; thence South
Two Hundred Twenty-seven (227)
feet; thence East Five Hundred
Seventy-five (575) feet; all in
Section Twenty-five (25), Town-
ship Forty-seven (47), Range
Twenty-seven (27).

SECTION 3. FILING. The Vil-
lage Clerk is hereby directed to
file certified copies of this Or-
dinance with the Minnesota Muni-
cipal Commission, the Secretary
of State, and the County Audi-
tor.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE
DATE. This ordinance takes ef-
fect upon its passage and pub-
lication and the filing of the
certified copies as directed in
Section 3.

has been the bookkeeper of the newspaper known

mat and in column and sheet form equivalent in
printed space to at least 900 square inches.

serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publi-
cation and is not made up entirely of patents, plate
matter and advertisements.
- (4) Is circulated in and near the municipality which it
purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly
delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of
at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid
and has entry as second-class matter in its local
postoffice.
- (5) Has its known office of issue in the Village of Aitkin,
in said county, established and open during its reg-
ular business hours for the gathering of news, sale
of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and main-
tained by the publisher or persons in his employ
and subject to his direction and control during all
such regular business hours and at which said news-
paper is printed.
- (6) Files a copy of each issue immediately with the State
Historical Society.
- (7) Has complied with all the foregoing conditions for
at least two years preceding the day or dates of pub-
lication mentioned below.
- (8) Has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota
prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 there-
after an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Sec-
retary of State and signed by an authorized official
and sworn to before a notary public stating that the
newspaper is a legal newspaper.

She further states on oath that the printed

ORDINANCE NO. 155

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF AITKIN, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED AND/OR UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 17, 1970, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 27 day of April, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described as approximately 60 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by 31 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of approximately 100 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Aitkin, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after proper notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the east and south boundaries thereof;

The Council of the Village of Aitkin, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the village of of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby


annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) lying and being North of the South right-of-way line of the Northern Pacific Railroad right-of-way as said right-of-way now exists;
All of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW), lying South of the existing Aitkin Village limits;
All of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), except that portion thereof described as follows; commencing at the southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$); running thence North Two Hundred Twenty-seven (227) feet; thence West Five Hundred Seventy-five (575) feet; thence South Two Hundred Twenty-seven (227) feet; thence East Five Hundred Seventy-five (575) feet; all in Section Twenty-five (25), Township Forty-seven (47), Range Twenty-seven (27).



Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.


