Ordinance No. 42-70

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF KERKHOVEN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the village at the East boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the village;

The village council of Kerkhoven ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Kerkhoven are hereby extended to include the property described as follows now owned by the village:

A strip of land in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Two (22), Township One Hundred Twenty (120), Range Thirty-seven (37), said strip being Seventy (70) feet in width, Thirty-five (35) feet on either side of the following described centerline: Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22); thence North on and along the West line of said Section a distance of Seven Hundred Seven and eight-tenths (707.8) feet to a point which is the place of beginning of said centerline; thence deflecting Easterly Ninety (90) degrees, Twenty-seven (27) minutes, running parallel with the South line of said Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22) a distance of One Hundred Fifty-five (155) feet; thence South and parallel with the West line of said Section Twenty-two (22) a distance of One Hundred Sixty-two and eight-tenths (162.8) feet and there terminating, all of said land lying and being in the County of Swift and State of Minnesota.

Section 2. Filing. The village clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
