

ORDINANCE NO 100

AN ORDINANCE including certain unplatted lands within the corporate limits of the Village of Cass Lake, Minnesota, and extending the boundaries of said Village so as to include said lands therein.

The VILLAGE COUNCIL, of the Village of Cass Lake do Ordain as follows:

Sec. I. That in accordance with the terms of a petition therefor, duly presented to the Village Council of said Village, and duly signed by a majority of the owners thereof, the following unplatted land of less than two hundred acres in extent, abutting upon the limits of said Village, to wit:

All those parts of Section Ten (10; in Township One Hundred Forty five (145) North of Range Thirty one (31, West, described as follows; All that part of the South west Quarter of the South west Quarter (SW1/4 of SW1/4) which lies south of the right of way of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault Ste Marie Railway Company as now located, and which lies east of a line running due north in a right line from a point on the south line of said Section Ten (10) aforesaid which ~~lies~~ is seven hundred seventy nine (779) feet east of the southwest corner of said Section Ten (10):

All of Government Lot Four (4), and all of the south east quarter of the south west quarter (SW1/4 of SW1/4);

All that part of Government Lot number Three (3, which lies east and south of the following described line, to wit; Beginning at the southwest corner of said Government Lot Three (3) and running thence north on the west line thereof Two Hundred (200) feet, to the (former) County Road center; thence north, sixty degrees east Three Hundred Fifty seven (357) feet to a point in the center of the (former) County Road; thence north, ten degrees east, Ninety (90) feet to a point in the center of the (former) County Road; thence north, sixty five degrees east, seven hundred ten (710) feet to a monument at the point where the south right of way line of the (former) County Road intersects the West Shore line of Cass Lake.

be and the same is hereby included within the corporate limits of the Village of Cass Lake, and the Village boundaries of the Village of Cass Lake are hereby extended as to include therein the above described lands.

Sec. II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its publication and the filing of a certified copy hereof in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

All of Government Lot Four (4), and all of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$).

All that part of Government Lot number Three (3) which lies east and south of the following described line, to-wit: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Government Lot Three (3) and running thence north on the west line thereof Two Hundred (200) feet, to the (former) County Road center; thence north, sixty degrees east Three Hundred Fifty-seven (357) feet to a point in the center of the (former) County Road; thence north, ten degrees east, Ninety (90) feet to a point in the center of the (former) County Road; thence north, sixty-five degrees east, seven hundred ten (710) feet to a monument at the point where the south right of way line of the (former) County Road intersects the West Shore line of Cass Lake.

Be and the same is hereby included within the corporate limits of the Village of Cass Lake, and the Village boundaries of the Village of Cass Lake are hereby extended as to include therein the above described lands.

Sec. II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its publication and the filing of a certified copy hereof in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
