THOMAS BRENNAN at the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) per annum, one-fourth of said amount to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of the Attorney General and three-fourths of said amount to be paid from the Milk and Dairy Fund.
