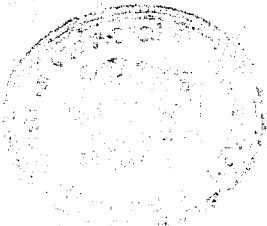

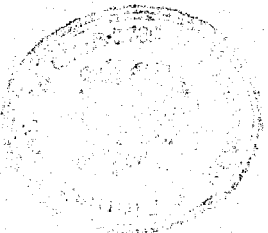

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Axel Solitander, duly appointed and accredited Consul General of the Republic of Finland to the United States of America, of which a certified copy of the exequatur is hereto annexed as evidence of such credentials, with General Offices in New York City, State of New York, do by these presents hereby make, constitute and appoint and designate Victor H. Gran, Attorney at Law, at Duluth, Minnesota, Consular representative with consular jurisdiction covering the state of Minnesota, with all the powers and duties that I possess by virtue of my office under the laws and constitution of the Republic of Finland, subject to the laws of said state of Minnesota; to settle claims for compensation and to receive for distribution to the persons entitled thereto, all compensation arising under the Compensation Act of the state of Minnesota for the death of Konstaa Ahokas, also known as John Aho, who died May 26, 1919, at Virginia, Minnesota, as a result of accidental injuries received May 9, 1919, at Fairbanks, Minnesota, while being there employed by Dunka River Lumber Company, and for the death of Oscar Granlund Kolinanta, who was killed August 20th, 1919, by Northern Pacific Railway train at Duluth, Minnesota, while in the employ of a certain Mr. Pastoret, both leaving surviving alien non-resident dependents residing in Finland; to settle, compromise and bring action for damages against the persons liable under Common Law for the wrongful death of said persons, for the benefit of their absent heirs, natives of Finland; to bring action against Moritz Heim for the collection of the sum of \$837.82 with interest from October 24, 1914, in behalf of Maria Wesala and Maria Wesala, her daughter, natives of and residing in Finland, being the amount of money turned over to said Moritz Heim by the administrator John Wesala in the estate of Peter Wesala, deceased, in the Probate Court, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

That I grant and give unto my said attorney full authority and power to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with

full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done by virtue hereof.
