of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General in the Department of Human Rights for the period commencing January 26, 1971, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said JAMES STOLPESTAD at the sum of Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$14,600) per annum, to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of Human Rights.
