PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WINGER

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD OF POLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, desiring to incorporate a Village within and covering the whole of said territory, do hereby respectfully petition your honorable body to call an election for the determination of such proposed village incorporation, said Village to be known, named and designated as the Village of Winger.

The territory above referred to, and proposed to be incorporated into and to become part of said Village, is described as follows, to wit:

The Northeast quarter ( $N\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the north half of the Southeast quarter ( $N\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section twenty-two (22) in Township one hundred forty-seven (147), North, of Range forty-two (42) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in said County of Polk and State of Minnesota, containing two hundred and forty acres.

In support of this petition we respectfully submit the following facts:

FIRST - That prior to the signing of this petition, to wit, on the 14th day of October, A. D. 1920, the undersigned did cause a census to be taken of the resident population within said territory, so proposed to be incorporated, and found, and so state the fact to be, that the total number of the population resident within such territory was two hundred and twelve (212).
