## PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WINGER

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD OF FOLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, desiring to incorporate a Village within and covering the whole of said territory, do hereby respectfully petition your honorable body to call an election for the determination of such proposed village incorporation, said Village to be known, named and designated as the Village of Winger.

The territory above referred to, and proposed to be incorporated into and to become part of said Village, is described as follows, to wit:

The Northeast quarter (NPA), and the north half of the Southeast quarter (NPSEA) of Section twenty-two (22) in Township one hundred forty-seven (17), North, of Mange forty-two (42) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in said County of Polk and State of Minnesota, containing two hundred and forty acres.

In support of this petition we respectfully submit the following facts:

FIRST - That prior to the signing of this petition, to wit, on the 14th
day of October, A. D. 1920, the undersigned did cause a census to be taken
of the resident population within said territory, so proposed to be incorporated, and found, and so state the fact to be, that the total number
of the population resident within such territory was two hundred and twelve(21/2)

SECOND - That the townsite of Winger, containing 40.4 acres, with its two additions, to wit, Highland Park Addition, containing about 12 acres, and Lawndale Addition, containing 5.88 acres, is contained and included in the said territory proposed to be incorporated, and that said townsite, and the said additions, have heretofore been duly platted into blocks and lots and the plats thereof have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Polk.

THIRD - That the unplatted portion of said territory adjoins the platted part thereof and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village government.

FOURTH - That the said territory so proposed to be incorporated as a village, includes two hundred and forty acres (240), and is bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section twenty-two (22), Township one hundred forty-seven (17) North, Bange forty-two (42) West, in said county, thence due west on the section line between sections fifteen (15) and twenty-two (22), said town and range, a distance of one hundred and sixty (160) rods, to the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said section twenty-two (22); thence due south to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NESE) of said Section twenty-two (22), a distance of two hundred and forty (240) rods; thence due east to the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (NESE) of said section twenty-two (22), a distance of one hundred and sixty (160) rods; thence due north on the section line bewteen said section (22) twenty-two/and thenty-three(23), in said town and range, a distance of two hundred and forty (240) rods, to theplace of beginning.

FIFTH - That no part of said territory is now, nor ever has been, in or part of any incorporated village.

WHEREFORE your petitioners ask that your honorable body cause an election to be called, as provided by law, for the determination of such proposed incorporation.
