PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, one hundred and ninety-five years ago, on Hovember 10, 1775, a Corps of Marines was created by a resolution of the Continental Congress to be formed of men so acquainted with maritime affairs as to be able to serve to advantage by sea onvvessels of the Continental Navy; and

WHEREAS, the record of the Merine Corps is one which will bear comparison with that of the most famous military organization of the world's history; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and appropriate that we recognize and remember the birth of the Marine Gorpa in which Marines have acquitted themselves with the greatest distinction, winning new honors in every bettle and skirmish until the term "MARINE" has come to signify all that is highest in military efficiency, soldierly virgue, and the cause of freedom:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclim the week of November 7, 1970, through November 13, 1970, as

MARINE CORFS WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge our citizens to join in tribute to the United States Marine Corps.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and of the State, the one hundred thirteenth.
