PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the United States Jaycees is an organization of young men dedicated to community betterment and individual development, and
- WHEREAS: in Minnesota there are over 190 local chapters and over 10,000 members, active in such areas as agriculture, community development, health, safety, conservation, international relations, religious activities, governmental affairs, youth and mental retardation, and
- WHEREAS: through the Jaycees, many opportunities are open for young men between the ages of 21 and 35 to be of service to their communities while developing leadership ability, and
- WHEREAS: membership is open to all young men to learn "that service to humanity is the best work of life," and
- WHEREAS: the civic business and service organizations of this State recognize that the Jaycees of Minnesota have contributed materially to the betterment of this State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 17 - 23, 1970, to be

"JAYCEE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and encourage young men interested in such service and personal development to join their local Jaycee chapter.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one and of the State the one hundred thirteenth.
