PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Vocational-technical education has made a major contribution to the human and economic growth in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Vocational-technical education is entering its fifty-fourth year of service to the development of human, economic, and natural resources of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Advisory Council for vocational education, 1970, has recommended in addition to article eight, section one, of the Minnesota Constitution that "Public" education must equitably serve every citizen. Public education must serve to assist each individual in determining his 'needs, interests and abilities,' and in developing his intellectual, civic, social and work competencies essential to human self-fulfillment."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1971, as

VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be cognizant of the many contributions made to our State by vocational-technical education and to encourage and support further expansion of vocational-technical education as an integral part of continuing education.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this first day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred thirteenth.
