

ORDINANCE NO. 496

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 469 DECLARING CERTAIN PLATTED LAND TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA.

The Common Council of the City of North Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 469 of the City of North Mankato be deleted in its entirety and the following be substituted in lieu thereof:

"(1) The following tract of land lying adjacent to the City of North Mankato and being in the County of Nicollet and described as follows:

"Commencing at the center of Section 11, Township 108 North, Range 27 West, thence South 89° 30' East (assumed bearing) along the center line of Lee Boulevard 1313.50 feet; thence North 0° 55.4' East, 466.69 feet to the point of beginning; from said point of beginning North a distance of 196.06 feet; thence due West a distance of 466.69 feet; thence due South a distance of 196.06 feet; thence due East a distance of 466.69 feet to the place of beginning, together with any and all streets, highways and other public right of ways within and adjacent to said described land; said tract containing two acres, more or less,

is hereby annexed and declared to be a part of the City of North Mankato and to be included in the corporate limits thereof."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its date of passage and publication.



AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PLATTED LAND TO BE
ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA.

The Common Council of the City of North Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain
as follows:

(1) The following tract of land lying adjacent to the City of North
Mankato and being in the County of Nicollet and described as follows:

Commencing at the center of Section 11, Township 108 North,
Range 27 West, thence South 89°30' (assumed bearing) along
