ORDINANCE NO. 192

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 188 EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. JAMES TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTY ABUTTING THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED By the City of St. James, Minnesota, as follows:

SEC. I. That Ordinance No. 188 extending the corporate limits of the City of St. James, Minnesota, to include certain property abutting thereon be amended by adding to the land description contained therein, following Section I, the following Section:

"I. A. The above described land shall include any and all public roads or rights of way, railroad rights of way or waterways within, adjacent or abutting upon said above described land."

SEC. II. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with appropriate parties as required by law.

SEC. III. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 of Bertholet's Subdivision of Government Lots 12 and 13, except that certain land now lying within the existing City limits of the City of St. James, Watonwan County, Minnesota.

Together with all public rights of way, roads, railroad rights of way or waterways within, adjacent or abutting upon said land.

The same being approximately 27 acres, more or less.



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ORDINANCE #188

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF ST. JAMES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN UN-INCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY
AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY



WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently with the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the city boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the city;

The City Council of the City of St. James, Minnesota does hereby ordain as follows:

Section I. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the City of St. James, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted property described as follows now owned by the City of St. James, Minnesota, to wit:

- I. All of Government Lots 11 and 14, Section 18, Township 106
 North, Range 31 West, excluding that part of Government Lot 11 owned by the Church of St. James, St. James, Minnesota.
- II. Also, all that part of Lots 5,6,7 and 8 of Bertholet's Subdivision of Lot 12 of Section 18, Township 108 North, Range 31 West described as follows:
 - 1) Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 8 of Bertholet's Subdivision of Lot 12 of Section 18, Township 106 North, Range 31 West; thence North along the West line of said Lot a distance of 286 feet; thence East and parallel with the North line of said lot a distance of 376 feet; thence South and parallel with the West line of said lot a distance of 286 feet; thence West and parallel with the North line of said lot a distance of 376 feet to the place of beginning being approximately 2.47 acres.
 - 2) Beginning at a point on the East line of said Lot 5, 33 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Lot 5; thence South along the East line of said Lots 5,6,7, and 8 to the Southeast corner of said Lot 8; thence West along the South line of said Lot 8 a distance of 32.6 feet "and to a point connected to the East line of the property now owned by the City of St. James" (sic), as extended South, a distance of 627 feet which point is 33 feet South of North boundary line of said Lot 5; thence East a distance of 326.6 feet to the point of beginning.
 - 3) Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Lot 5; thenœ East along the North line thereof to the Northeast corner of said Lot

5; thence South along the East line of said Lot 5, a distance of 33 feet; thence West on a line parallel with the North line of said Lot 5 a distance of 326.6 feet; thence South on a line parallel with the West line of said Lot 5 a distance of 217.6 feet; thence West on a line parallel with the North line of said Lot 5 a distance of 400 feet; thence North on a line parallel with the West line of said Lot 5 a distance of 217.6 feet; thence West on a line parallel with the North line of said Lot 5 a distance of 530 feet to the West line of said Lot 5; thence North on (the) West Line of said Lot 5 a distance of 53 feet to the place of beginning.

III. 1) Also, all that part of Government Lots 2,3,5,6 and 7 of the Northwest quarter of Section 18, Township 106 North, Range 31 West described as follows:

12 acres beginning 316-8/10 feet West of (the) Southeast corner of Lot 6, Section 18, Township 106 North, Range 31 West, the line of tract hereby conveyed runs in a westerly direction along the South line of said Lot 6, 478 feet; thence in a northerly direction at right angles to said South line 981 feet to (the) right of way of Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis & Omaha Railway Company; thence northeasterly along said right of way 528 feet to a point North of (the) point of beginning; thence Southerly to (the point of) beginning 1239-5/10 feet.

2) All of the property described below which lies North of the North bank of the creek that passes through said property in a easterly and westerly direction, the entire property being described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 6 in Section 18, Township 106 North, Range 31 West, running thence in a westerly direction along the South line of said Lot 6, 4.80 chains; thence in a northly direction at right angles to the South line of said Lot 6, 18.78 chains to the South Line of the right of way of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis & Omaha Railway Company; thence in a northeasterly direction along the South right of way line to the East line of Lot 3 of said Section 18; thence in a southerly direction along the East line of said Lots 3 and 6 of said Section 18, 21.03 chains to the place of beginning,

It being the intention of the parties to this deed that only that portion of the property above described lying North of the North boundary of creek running through said property be conveyed.

3) From the point of intersection of West line of said Section with the North line of the right of way of said Railroad Company, running thence northeasterly along said right of way line 2156 feet; thence northerly at right angles a distance of 66 feet to the point of commencement; thence in a northerly direction and at right angles to said Railway right of way a distance of 200 feet; thence in a southwesterly direction and at right angles a distance of 50 feet; thence in a southeasterly direction and at right angles a distance of 200 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction and at

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right angles a distance of 50 feet to the point of commencement.

Also commencing on the West line of said Lot 2 on the South of Railroad right of way, running thence South 646 feet to an oak post on the South bank of St. James Creek; thence North 33 degrees, East 542 feet to a stone boulder; thence North 340 feet to railroad right of way; thence along railroad right of way South 64 degrees, West 328 feet to (the) place of beginning.

4) Commencing at the point of intersection of the West line of said Section with North line of right of way of said Railway Company; running thence northeasterly along said right of way line 2656 feet; thence northerly at right angles 266 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles 500 feet; thence southerly at right angles 200 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles and parallel to said right of way line to West line of said Section; thence South on said Section line to (the) point of beginning.

Also, beginning at the southeasterly corner of the tract above described and being a point on said railway right of way line 2656 feet northeasterly of the point of intersection of the West line of said Section with said North right of way line; thence northeasterly on said right of way line 393 feet; thence northerly at right angles 66 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles to East line of the tract first herein described; thence southerly on (the) East line of said tract 66 feet to (the) point of beginning.

Section II. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Watonwan County and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section III. Effective date of annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in section II.
