- WHEREAS, the observance of Business Education Week will be observed at the 1971 annual spring convention of the Minnesota Business Education Association in the Hobler Hotel in Rochester on April 23 and 24, 1971, in honor of instructors, administrators, exhibitors and representatives of business organizations cooperating in sponsoring this event,
