

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Truly dedicated American citizenship in our proud Nation is expressed through each individual's conscious devotion to the Constitution and safeguarding of our inborned freedoms, and readiness to defend our nation against all enemies, whatsoever; and

WHEREAS, The patriotic unity of our people is today challenged by un-American influences seeking to undermine and to destroy freedom around the world; and

WHEREAS, Such devotion to the American way of life can best be manifested through the heartfelt patriotic reaffirmation of all of our truly loyal citizens who served under the flag defense of our ideals and borders, in all cases and throughout every State of the Union; now

THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby issue this the First day of May as

LOYALTY DAY

and I urge that every individual, school, church, organization, business establishment and household within my official jurisdiction do vigorously reaffirm patriotic allegiance to our Flag and Country, through active participation in patriotic public programs sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and its co-sponsors on LOYALTY DAY, May 1, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred thirtieth.
