- WHEREAS, the American Production and Inventory Control Society, Inc., was organized in 1957 and has grown to over 8,000 members in over 127 chapters throughout the United States, one territory, and two international affiliates; and
- WHEREAS, the primary objectives of this international professional society are to develop professional efficiency in production and inventory management through study, research, and application of scientific methods and thereby advance the general welfare of the industrial economy; and
- WHEREAS, the National-International Organization has scheduled its Ninth Annual International Conference and Technical Exhibit at St. Louis, Missouri on November 3, 4, and 5, 1971, at which time the International President, Mr. Arthur Egan, will take occasion to observe the fact this is the third time in its history APIOS to bring significantly increased by the volume of the participation; and
